#### **BOARD OBJECTIVE**

The work of the Awards and Admission Committee is broken out over the course of the academic year. In the fall semester the committee will work to select the recipients of the Alumni Association Graduation Awards for each of the university's five colleges (Arts & Sciences, Business, Law, Music + Media, Nursing & Health). The committee will accomplish this by reviewing the application each year before it is sent out to students, suggesting edits, ensuring it goes out to students in a timely manner, helping to promote it to students, reviewing the applications, interviewing applicants, and finally selecting the recipients of the awards by December 1.

In the spring semester, the committee will focus on identifying best practices for alumni support of admissions and enrollment efforts in an effort to establish similar processes at Loyola. This work will conclude with a presentation of the findings by the committee to the full Alumni Association Board for their consideration and feedback.

#### **Career Development Committee**

The Career Development Committee aims to leverage the Alumni Association to support the professional development of Loyola students. The committee shall identify and define professional development strategies, tactics and metrics in collaboration with the Career Development Center and serve as the key informant and stakeholder alumni group for the Office of Alumni Engagement and the Career Development Center. The key tasks of the committee are to identify and define ways in which alumni can support students' exploration of career paths; share best practices from life experiences; and review offerings from Loyola and offer suggestions.
